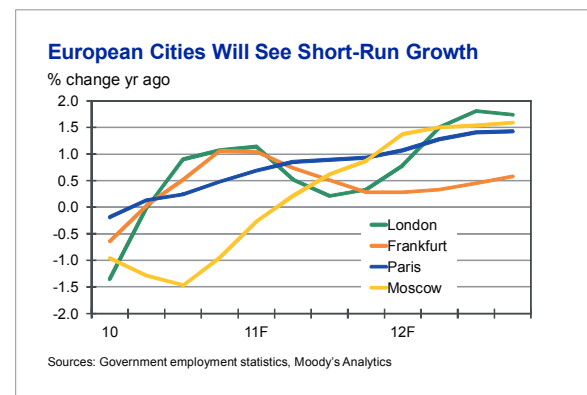

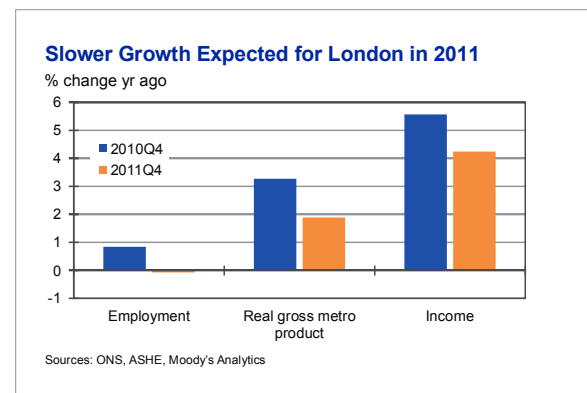
Applications
